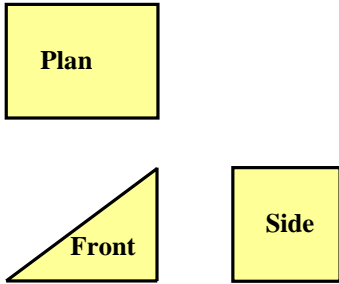

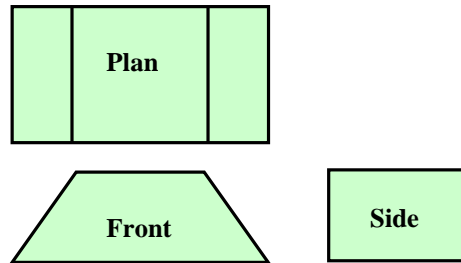

 In each case draw a three-dimensional sketch of the object.

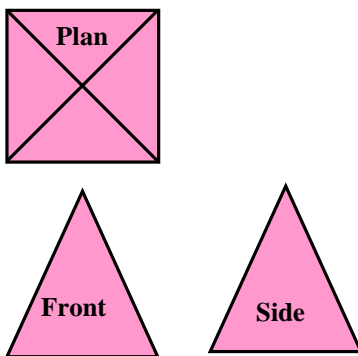
